

Baseline Survey on Youth Livelihoods & Education (2023)

1. Project Overview

- **Objective:** Assess youth livelihoods, education access, and environmental awareness to inform community development programs and advocacy.
- Location: Mongu & Senanga Districts, Western Province, Zambia.
- **Timeline:** March December 2023.

2. Background & Rationale

- **Context:** Youth in Western Province face high unemployment, low educational attainment, and limited livelihood options. Evidence gaps hinder effective policymaking and targeted interventions.
- Rationale: A participatory baseline survey was essential to generate evidence-based insights guiding Chistone's programmatic interventions in livelihoods, education, and environmental awareness.

3. Activity Components

a) Surveys & Data Collection

- 350 households and 120 youth engaged.
- Collected quantitative and qualitative data on education, income, and environmental perceptions.

b) Policy & Community Dialogues

- Organized validation workshops with communities and district officials.
- Developed policy briefs with actionable recommendations.

4. Detailed Execution Phases

Phase 1: Planning & Tool Design (Mar-Apr 2023)

- Designed survey tools with stakeholder input.
- Recruited and trained 15 youth enumerators.

Phase 2: Household & Youth Surveys (May–Jul 2023)

- Conducted door-to-door household surveys (350).
- Held 10 youth focus group discussions.

Phase 3: Data Analysis & Policy Briefing (Aug-Sep 2023)

- Analyzed survey data using SPSS.
- Drafted policy briefs on youth livelihoods and education access.





Phase 4: Dissemination & Community Feedback (Oct-Dec 2023)

- Hosted 2 district-level dissemination workshops.
- Shared findings with district councils, schools, and local leaders.

- Evidence Produced: Comprehensive baseline survey report.
- **Policy Influence:** Findings integrated into 2 district youth strategies.
- **Community Empowerment:** Youth involved in research gained practical research skills.
- **Awareness Raised:** Local leaders adopted evidence-based bylaws on youth skills training and education support.
